UNIT 1. HELLO!

- Language Function: Exchanging greetings and leave-taking.
- Grammar: Personal Pronouns. Articles. Demonstratives. Possessives. Apostrophe S.
- Appendix: Greeting and leave-taking. Treatments of formality.
- Topic: Numbers. School and work. Jobs and professions.

UNIT 2. MY NAME IS ALICE.

- Language Function: Giving personal information.
- Grammar: Nouns (singular and plural, regular and irregular, countable and uncountable). Prepositions of place, movement and time.
- Phonology: Pronouncing plurals.
- Appendix Commands
- Topic: The Family. Prepositions. Feelings and emotions.

UNIT 3. MY FRIEND DAVID IS CLEVER AND FUNNY.

- Language Function: Describing people, objects and places. Expressing simple comparisons.
- Grammar: Adjectives (including comparatives and superlatives). There is/are and has/have got/have you got?
- Topic: Shopping. Parts of the body.

UNIT 4. WE GO TO THE SAME UNIVERSITY.

- Language Function: Describing daily routines. Giving dates. Asking simple questions about everyday life. Describing frequency.
- Grammar: Present simple tense. Formation of questions and the use of question words. Adverbs of frequency.
- Topic: Times and dates. Adverbs and adverbial phrases of frequency.

- Language Function: Expressing ability and inability.
- Grammar: Can and can't. Count and uncount names.
- Topic: Hobbies and sports. Food.
